

Lead In Paints

- Used as White Pigment Into 1950s
- Continued Use in Some Pigments and Additives; Outlawed in 1978
- Ingestion and Inhalation Can Cause Severe Nervous and Developmental Disorders
- Do Not Scrape, Sand, Burn or Otherwise Put Paint Into Environment if Lead May be Present
- Lead Test Kits Are of Value Only With Positive Reading
- Use Lead Testing Service if in Doubt
- Consider Use of Lead Abatement Service
